**1.0 INTRODUCTION:**

- 1.1 M/s Assam Petrochemicals Limited (APL/Owner), a public sector undertaking under the Govt. of Assam, was set up in the year 1976 with facilities for production of 30 TPD of Methanol & 50 TPD formaldehyde based on Natural Gas. The company expanded its operation by setting up new Methanol Plant of 100 TPD capacity based on I.C.I Technology in the year 1986 and a new Formaldehyde Plant of 100 TPD capacity with technology from DERIVADOS, Spain.

APL is now setting up a new integrated 500 TPD Methanol Plant and 200 TPD Acetic Acid Plant adjacent to its existing plant at Namrup, along with captive power plant and various utility plants catering to these process units. The feedstock for the project is Natural Gas. The present job, being executed with Engineers India Limited (EIL) as the Consultant, includes the 500 TPD Methanol Plant along with associated offsite facilities comprising of captive power plant and utility plants for the new integrated project.

- 1.2 Engineers India Limited (EIL), on behalf of M/s Assam Petrochemicals Limited (APL), invites e-bids from competent agencies with sound technical experience and financial capabilities meeting the Bidder's Qualification Criteria through e-tendering on domestic competitive bidding basis for "**PILING WORKS FOR METHANOL UNIT & OFFSITE**", as detailed below and in various sections of the Bidding Document.

**2.0 BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK:**

- 2.1 The work covers the supply, installation and testing of bored cast-in-situ straight shaft RCC piles for Integrated 500 TPD Methanol & 200 TPD Acetic Acid Plant at Namrup, Assam of M/s APL.

**2.2 Pile Details**

2.3 Carrying out initial Pile Load test on the test piles specially installed for the purpose and routine Pile Load test and Pile Integrity Test on job piles selected randomly by the Engineer-in-Charge.

- 4.1 Bidder can view/ download the complete Bidding Document from any one of the websites mentioned at Sl. No. **4.0 a)** above. However, bidders have to submit their bids only through Govt. e-tendering website <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> as mentioned at Sl. No. **4.0 i)** above.
- 4.2 **All revisions, amendments, time extensions, clarifications, etc. to the NIT/bidding document shall be uploaded in the websites only and shall not be published in Newspapers. Bidders should regularly visit the above website(s) to keep themselves updated and submit their Bids based on latest information.**
- 4.3 Request for extension or any queries received from any bidder with less than four working days prior to bid due date shall generally be ignored, since there will not be adequate time for proper communication with Client, other bidders and web hosting.
- 4.4 Bidders shall submit the bid directly and in their own name without involving any intermediaries.
- 4.5 Request for sending Bidding Document by Post/ Courier or any other mode shall not be entertained.

## 5.0 BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (BQC):

Bidders intending to participate shall fulfil the following qualification criteria:

### 5.1 EXPERIENCE CRITERIA (TECHNICAL)

- i) Bidder on his own should have executed and completed bored **cast *in-situ*** straight shaft **RCC piles of diameter 500 mm and above** of total length as per the following criteria during **last seven (7) years** period reckoned from the due date of submission of bids.

I. Total piling not less than **47,500 meters in a single contract.**

**OR**

II. Total piling not less than **28,500 meters each in two contracts.**

### 5.2 EXPERIENCE CRITERIA (COMMERCIAL)

- i) The bidder should have successfully completed work(s) of minimum value(s) as indicated below against the same work order(s)/contract(s) as will be considered in **Clause 5.1 i)** above:

**One Contract** of value not less than of **Rs. 25 Crore (Rupees Twenty Five Crore Only)**

**OR**

**Two Contracts** of value each not less than **Rs. 15 Crore (Rupees Fifteen Crore Only)**

- ii) For Experience (Technical and Commercial) based on **composite works**:
- a) In case Bidder has executed composite work(s) which include(s) any of the qualifying work(s) stated at **Clause 5.1 i) and 5.2 i)** above as per scope of work for the subject work, then value of such qualifying work(s) out of the total value of composite works shall be considered for the purpose of qualification.
- b) For composite works, in the event the value of the qualifying work(s) cannot be ascertained from the work order/ completion certificate submitted by bidder, Copy of Schedule of Rates (SOR), relevant pages of Contracts, Copy of relevant pages of final bill certified by Owner for establishing requirement of BQC or written letter from their Owner specifying the nature of work with quantities and values can be submitted for qualification.
- iii) **A job executed by a bidder for its own plant/projects cannot be considered as experience** for the purpose of meeting requirement of BQC as mentioned above. However, jobs executed for **Subsidiary/Fellow subsidiary/Holding company** will be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BQC subject to submission of tax paid invoice(s) duly certified by Statutory auditor of the Bidder towards payments of statutory tax in support of the job executed for Subsidiary/Fellow subsidiary/Holding company. Such bidders shall submit these documents in addition to the documents specified at **Clause No. 5.4** below to meet BQC.
- iv) A job completed by a bidder as a **sub-contractor** shall be considered for the purpose of meeting the experience criteria of BQC subject to submission of following documents in support of meeting the "Bidder's Qualification Criteria":
- a) Copy of work order and completion certificates along with SOR issued by main contractor. The Completion Certificates shall have details like work order no. /date, brief scope of work, ordered & executed value of the job, completion date etc.
- b) Certificates from the end User/ Owner/Consultant of the Owner substantiating that the agency is approved/ authorized sub-contractor for the works sublet to him by main contractor.

### 5.3 FINANCIAL CRITERIA

- i) Annual Turnover of the Bidder shall not be less than **Rs. 50 Crore (Rupees Fifty Crore Only)** as per audited annual financial results in any of the **last 3 (Three) preceding financial years**.
- ii) **Net Worth** of the Bidder as per immediate preceding year's audited financial results should be at least **Rs. 5 Crore (Rupees Five Crore Only)** as per the last audited financial statement.

Net Worth means paid up share capital, Share Application Money pending allotment\* and reserves# less accumulated losses and deferred expenditure to the extent not written off.

#Reserves to be considered for the purpose of Net Worth shall be all reserves created out of the profits and securities premium account but shall not include reserves created out of revaluation of assets, write back of depreciation and amalgamation.

\*Share Application Money pending allotment will be considered only in respect of share to be allotted.

Accordingly, the definition of Net Worth shall be as follows:

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- iii) Bidder should have minimum **Working Capital** equal to **Rs. 5 Crore (Rupees Five Crore Only)** as per the immediate preceding year's audited financial results

Working Capital shall be Current Assets minus Current Liabilities.

In case bidder is unable to meet the working capital requirement as above, the bidder can supplement the working capital with a line of credit from any scheduled bank in India. In such a case, bidder shall furnish a declaration from the bank for availability of line of credit for at least **Rs. 5 Crore**, in the format enclosed as **Appendix-B to NIT**.

### 5.4 DOCUMENTS AND DATA REQUIRED WITH BID

- i) **FOR EXPERIENCE CRITERIA (TECHNICAL AND COMMERCIAL)**

The bidder shall, in his own interest, furnish complete documentary evidence to justify that the bidder meets the Qualification Criteria as per **Clause 5.1 and 5.2** of this NIT as given above.

The documents to be furnished should include the following:

- a) Work order of bored cast *in-situ* RCC piling works mentioning the value and the scope of work as documentary evidence.
- b) Documentary evidence of successful completion of Bored cast *in-situ* RCC piling works from the Client. Completion certificate shall contain volume of work in terms of total length indicating diameter and length of pile installed.

- c) The Completion Certificate at SI no. **5.4 i) b)** above should mention the final executed value of the work and actual date of completion of work.

Failure to meet the above qualifying criteria(s) will render the bid to be summarily rejected. Therefore, the bidder shall in his own interest furnish complete documentary evidence including certificates(s) from the Owner(s) of the work executed etc., to justify that the bidder meets the qualifying criteria.

ii) **FOR FINANCIAL CRITERIA**

- (a) Bidder to evidence the meeting of financial criteria shall furnish the complete audited annual reports including auditor's reports, balance sheets, profit & loss accounts statement and all other schedules for the preceding three financial years
- (b) In case, audited annual report of immediate preceding financial year is not available in cases where bid closing date is up to 30th September, the bidder has an option to submit the audited annual reports of the three previous years immediately prior to the last financial year. However, in case the bid closing date is after 30th September, bidder has to compulsorily submit the audited annual reports for the immediate three preceding financial years only.
- (c) In case of a bidder, being a subsidiary company, separate annual report is not published and only consolidated report of the Parent Company is available, consolidated turnover shall be considered

5.5 Bidder shall complete and submit the duly filled in **Proposal Forms** included in the bidding document along with the above documentary evidence in support of their meeting the Bidder's Qualification Criteria as per **Clause no. 5.1, 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4** above.

- i) The BQC documents shall include but not limited to copies of work order(s) / contract agreements(s) / relevant pages of contract document(s), completion certificate(s) of similar works executed, fulfilling the qualification criteria, complete audited annual reports containing auditor's reports, audited balance sheets and profit & loss accounts statement with all schedules etc.

APL/ EIL reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished by the bidder along with the Bid without seeking any additional information.

- ii) All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the experience and financial criteria of BQC shall be submitted in a separate section/booklet along with their offer. This section/booklet shall be titled and submitted as **mentioned in Clause 13.0** below with proper index and page numbering. Refer Instructions to Bidders (ITB) for details.

iii) **AUTHENTICATION OF BQC DOCUMENTS:**

All documents furnished by the bidder in support of meeting the Experience Criteria (Technical and Commercial) of BQC shall be:

Either

Duly certified by Statutory Auditors of the bidder or practicing Chartered Accountant (not being an employee or a Director or not having any interest in the bidder's company/firm) where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law.

Or

Duly notarized by any Notary Public in the Bidder's Country. In case of Notarization, Bidder shall also submit an Affidavit, duly notarized in the Format provided as **Appendix-A** to this NIT, signed by the Authorized Signatory of the Bidder.

- iv) Any additional documents if deemed necessary to establish the qualifying requirements may also be submitted by the Bidder.
- v) Submission of authentic documents is the prime responsibility of the Bidder. However, APL/EIL reserves the right of getting the document cross verified, at their discretion from the document issuing authority.
- vi) APL/EIL reserves the right to complete the evaluation based on the details furnished (without seeking any additional information) and / or in-house data, survey or otherwise.
- vii) Failure to meet the above Qualification Criteria will render the Bid to be summarily rejected. Therefore, the bidder shall in his own interest furnish complete documentary evidence in the first instance itself along with their bids, in support of their fulfilling the Qualification Criteria as given above.

## **6.0 PRE-BID MEETING**

- 6.1 Bidders are requested to attend a pre-bid meeting on the date, time and at the address mentioned in **Clause 4.0 f)** above.
- 6.2 The bidder may send their queries, if any, on the Bidding Document through e-mail addressed to [anil.biswas@eil.co.in](mailto:anil.biswas@eil.co.in) , [bk.maharana@eil.co.in](mailto:bk.maharana@eil.co.in) to reach EIL at least **4 (four) working days** prior to pre-bid meeting. These queries shall be replied to the best extent possible during the Pre-bid meeting. Bidders or their authorized representatives are requested to attend the Pre-Bid Meeting so that their queries, if any, related to the Bidding document and Scope of Work can be addressed during the pre-bid meeting.
- 6.3 The queries raised (without identifying the sources of the query) and the EIL/Owner's responses will be hosted in the above websites.
- 6.4 Non-attendance of the pre-bid meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of a bidder.

## **7.0 SITE VISIT**

- 7.1 Namrup, the location of the project, is situated in the district of Dibrugarh, Assam, India. Bidder is advised to visit and examine the site (at his own cost), its surroundings and familiarise themselves of the existing facilities & environment, and collect all other information which he may require for preparing and submitting the bid and entering into the Contract. Claims and objections due to ignorance of existing conditions or inadequacy of information will not be considered after submission of the bid and during implementation. Bidder shall provide **at least two days in advance** the details of their representatives along with details of laptop etc., if any, being carried so as to make arrangement for gate passes.

## **8.0 MSEs Preferences:**

- a) **Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises notified the Public Procurement Policy (PPP), 2012** for facilitating promotion and development of micro & small enterprises.
- b) In case the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise registered with District Industries Centers or Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi and Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises:
  - i. Tender Documents shall be issued to MSEs free of cost.
  - ii. MSEs shall be exempted from payment of EMD.

- c) MSE bidder shall submit the following:
- iii. Documentary evidence that the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprises registered with District Industries Centers or Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi and Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.
  - iv. If the MSE is owned by SC/ST Entrepreneurs, the bidder shall furnish appropriate documentary evidence in this regard.
  - v. There should be clear categorisation in certificate that whether bidder is small scale enterprises or Micro scale enterprises.
  - vi. The above documents submitted by the bidder shall be duly certified (in original) by a Notary Public or Statutory Auditor of the bidder or a practicing Chartered Accountant (not being an employee or a Director or not having any interest in the bidder's company/firm) where audited accounts are not mandatory as per law.
  - vii. If the bidder does not provide the appropriate document or any evidence to substantiate the above, then it will be presumed that he does not qualify for any preference admissible in the Public Procurement Policy, 2012.

**d) Price preference as admissible under the prevailing procurement policy for MSEs shall not be applicable for subject tender.**

## **9.0 INTEGRITY PACT**

- 9.1 The Integrity Pact duly signed by the authorized official of APL and the Contractor will form part of this contract. The bidder shall comply with the requirements of the Integrity Pact.

Pro-forma of Integrity Pact, which is issued along with the bidding document shall be returned by the bidder along with technical bid, duly signed by the same signatory who signs the bid i.e. who is duly authorized to sign the bid. All the pages of the Integrity Pact shall be duly signed by the same signatory.

**Bidder's failure to return the integrity pact along with the bid, duly signed, shall lead to outright rejection of such bid.**

If the bidder has been disqualified from the tender process prior to the award of contract according to the provisions under Integrity Pact, APL shall be entitled to demand and recover from bidder Liquidated Damages amount by forfeiting the EMD/Bid security (Bid Bond) as per provisions of Integrity Pact.

If the contract has been terminated according to provisions of the Integrity Pact, or if APL is entitled to terminate the contract according to provisions of Integrity Pact, APL shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor Liquidated Damages amount by forfeiting the Performance Bank Guarantee / Security Deposit as per Integrity Pact.

## **10.0 SUBMISSION OF e-BIDS & VALIDITY**

- 10.1 Bids are required to be submitted only through Govt. of India Central Public Procurement Portal (CPP Portal) at <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> on or before the Bid submission date and time. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the CPP Portal (URL: <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>). No enrolment fee would be charged from the bidders. It may also be noted that the price details are required to be filled & submitted only on the Schedule of Rates / Schedule of Price format downloaded from above e-Tendering website.



- 10.2 Bidders in their own interest are requested to enroll on Govt. of India CPP portal and upload/submit their bid well in time. In the event of failure in bidder's connectivity with EIL/CPP Portal during the last few hours, bidder is likely to miss the deadline for bid submission. Due date extension request due to above reason may not be entertained.
- 10.3 Physical Bids / Offers or Bids through any other mode shall not be accepted. The Offers submitted through e-tendering system, as above shall only be considered for evaluation and ordering.
- 10.4 Bidders to refer Instruction to Bidders for E-Tendering Methodology provided as [Annexure-I](#) to Instructions to Bidders (ITB), in the Bidding Document. Bidders are requested to get acquainted with the E-Tendering System in advance and obtain/seek clarifications, if any, from EIL and/or CPP Portal Helpdesk, whose contact information is provided in the [Annexure-I](#) to ITB.
- 10.5 The Bid shall be valid for a period as mentioned in [Cl. 4.0 h](#)) above from the final due date of opening of Techno-commercial (Un-priced) Bids.
- 11.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / BID SECURITY**
- 11.1 Amount of EMD shall be as mentioned at [Clause No. 4.0 d\)](#) above shall be submitted within the Bid Due Date. The bidder shall submit the EMD/ Bid Security in the form of **Crossed Demand Draft or irrevocable Bank Guarantee** in favour of “**Assam Petrochemicals Limited**”, payable at **Guwahati**. Bank Guarantee shall be on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value as per proforma enclosed in the Bidding Document. EMD shall be uploaded in designated place in CPP Portal <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> .
- 11.2 **Bidder shall write their name and tender number on the backside of the cross demand draft being submitted against EMD/ Bid Security.**
- 11.3 The bank guarantee in lieu of EMD shall be valid for **6 (Six) months from the final Bid Due Date of submission of Bid**. Bank guarantee shall be revalidated for extended period as required by Owner / EIL in writing. APL shall not be liable to pay any bank charges, commission or interest on the amount of bid security.
- 11.4 In case, bid security is in the form of irrevocable Bank Guarantee the same shall be from any Indian scheduled Bank or nationalized bank or an Indian branch of an International bank situated in India and registered with the Reserve Bank of India as scheduled foreign bank.
- 11.5 Bids without Earnest Money Deposit(EMD) / Bid Security will not be considered and shall be summarily rejected, subject to exemptions as mentioned at [Clause No. 12.0](#) below.
- 11.6 Swift message/Cheque/Cash shall not be acceptable. In case bidder, fails to upload scanned copy of EMD on CPP Portal by the bid due date & time, such bid shall not be considered for evaluation.
- 11.7 For submission of EMD/Bid Security, in Original, refer [Clause no. 13.0](#) below
- 12.0 EXEMPTION OF EMD & BIDDING DOCUMENT FEE**
- 12.1 EMD & Bidding Document Fee (if applicable) shall not be required to be submitted by Micro & Small units registered with District Industries Centers or Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi and Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as well as by Indian Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/ Enterprises (PSEs).
- 12.2 **Industries registered with MSEs shall provide necessary documentary evidence duly certified by statutory auditor or Notary Public as per bidding**

document, whereas PSUs shall submit declaration to this effect in their letter head that they are PSU.

- 12.3 **Exemption of EMD will be applicable as mentioned above provided that certificate issued by the competent authority is valid on the date of Un-priced Bid Opening in case of MSEs. Scanned copy of registration certificate duly certified by Statutory Auditor or Notary Public for MSEs and self-declaration by PSUs/PSEs should be uploaded at the designated place in the e-procurement website.**

### 13.0 **SUBMISSION OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS (IN HARD COPY)**

- 13.1 The following documents shall be submitted in **ORIGINAL** including the authenticated documents against Bidder's Qualification Criteria and for detailed evaluation of Bid, **within 7 days from the date of unpriced e-Bid opening** in the CPP Portal, in a sealed envelope, with proper index and covering letter in bidder's letter head. The envelope shall be titled "**EMD, ORIGINAL BQC DOCUMENTS AND SIGNED INTEGRITY PACT AND POWER OF ATTORNEY**" with the Name of the Work, Bidding Document No., Name of the Project etc. along with the Bidder's name and address with contact no. etc. and shall be submitted to the address as mentioned in **clause 4.0 k)** above:

- i) **Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security**
